What To Expect

Some Troop Events for Scouts to adjust to Scouts BSA

- Early March First Troop Meeting for New Scouts crossing over from Cub Scouts
- Soon after Joining Scout Overnight Lock-In (get to know other Scouts)
- Usually in March Scout Sunday at Trinity Presbyterian (show our gratitude to Trinity)
- 3rd Week of March Tahosa Cabins Campout – First campout for new Scouts
- 3rd Week of April First regular Troop campout
- Last Week of April Denver Area Scout Show
- Every month A Campout at a variety of locations
- Sometime in May Mother/Son Breakfast
- Sometime in May Troop Court-of-Honor (awards ceremony – 4 times per year)
- Sometime in summer Summer Camp (one week, either in Council, in-state or out-of-state).
- August Scout Planning Retreat (Scouts plan next year's activities)
- November Adult Planning Retreat (Adults seek to schedule Scout's plans)
- January Winter Camping at Fraser, Colorado
